The Collection of the Late Sir Geoffrey Harmsworth



Sir Arthur Geoffrey Annesley Harmsworth, 3rd Baronet, was born in 1904 and died in 1980, unmarried, his baronetcy then becoming extinct. He was the son of Robert Leicester Harmsworth, 1st Baronet and the nephew of Lord Northcliffe.

Familiarly known as Sir Geoffrey, he had many associations with the County of Lincolnshire and in particular the Town of Louth and the Village of Tealby. Sir Geoffrey made his country home at Thorpe Hall, Louth in 1938, residing there for about 15 years although interrupted by the war years. He later sold Thorpe Hall to Sir John Marsden formerly of Panton Hall, near Wragby and acquired White Cottage, Tealby where he lived until his death.

Sir Geoffrey, a Fellow of the Society of Antiquities was a great supporter of Lincoln Cathedral and associated artists including Peter de Wint and his followers. He researched the history of Louth, Tealby and surrounding areas.

Sir Geoffrey was educated at Harrow School, a War Correspondent during the early part of World War II, later serving in the RAF Volunteer Reserve war and gaining the rank of Squadron Leader.

Initially residing in London at 8, Stratton Street, Sir Geoffrey became a director of the Daily Mail and General Trust, Chairman of the Harmsworth Press and associate publications including The Field Magazine.
